Dear Parent/Carer

This year all our Year 7 pupils will have the exciting opportunity to take part in a reward scheme named '**Faith in Action Award**', a nationally recognised award run by the Shrewsbury Youth Mission Team.

The Faith in Action Award encourages young people through recognising, rewarding and celebrating their active service and reflection. The Award helps them to connect their life and faith in a tangible manner. In journeying through the Award, young people should experience a deepening of their relationship with God and find themselves exploring that relationship. It is hoped that through their relationship and action, others will see God's love through them.

What's involved?

The Faith in Action Award rewards young people's active service to others in their local and wider community. Young people accrue credits of service and reflect on that service in the context of the teachings of the Catholic Church throughout their award journey.

There are four levels of award and our pupils will be working towards the Pin level. This level is designed to be completed as a group/ class during Year 7, instilling the idea of working together as a community. In this way, participants will become aware that others around them are on the same journey of discovery.

Participants will need to accrue 20 credits within this academic year to gain the Award. Credits can be earned through activities such as fundraising, charity events, active participation in the liturgy and mass and taking an active part in the 2 reflection points throughout the year. A lot of the activities that ASCC offers will fulfil the requirements of the Pin Award.

Our pupils have already been involved a variety of activities that will have accrued credits such as collecting food for the CAFOD food bank (1 credit). Activities such as this will be evaluated, evidence will be collected and pupils will keep a record of everything they do in a scrap book with their Religious Education teacher.

At the end of the academic year there will be a certificate award to each pupil by the Shrewsbury Youth Mission Team.

This is an exciting opportunity for our pupils at All Saints Catholic College. I look forward to your son/daughter's involvement.
