



## GCSE Results Day – Year 11

We are pleased to confirm that GCSE Results Day for Year 11 will take place on **Thursday 20th August**.

Students are warmly invited to collect their results from **9:00am to 11:30am** in the **Hall**. Entry will be via the usual pupil gate onto the main yard.

If a student is unable to collect their results in person, alternative arrangements can be made. To ensure confidentiality, we do require **written permission from the student in advance**, and results cannot be released without this.

If collecting in person is not possible, students may request one of the following options:

### Option 1 – By post

Please email the Exams Officer with the address the results should be sent to.

### Option 2 – By email

Please email the Exams Officer from a personal email account to request this.

Please note that there may be a slight delay in sending results electronically due to the volume of requests on the day.

### Option 3 – By a representative

A named person can collect the results on the student's behalf. Please email the Exams Officer with the representative's name in advance. The representative must bring valid ID, as results cannot be released without this.
