

Year 11 GCSE exams and information

Well done to our Year 11 pupils for completing their first full week of exams!

Year 11 pupils will start their study leave on Monday 2nd of June after the half term break. The last official full day for Year 11 will be on Friday 23rd of May. On this day, pupils have an exam in the morning and so must come to school in full uniform. Pupils will begin to sign shirts after lunchtime, and a celebration assembly will be held for Year 11 pupils in the afternoon.

This means that after the 2nd of June, pupils are able to go home in between exams. For pupils who prefer to stay and work at school, revision spaces will always be available and teachers are on hand to support.
