Year 7 Catch-Up Premium 2016-17

The Year 7 catch-Up premium has been offered by the Government as a commitment to provide additional funding to schools. This is aimed at each year 7 pupil who did not achieve at least 100 in the end of Key Stage 2 national curriculum tests in reading and/or mathematics. The purpose of this funding is to enable All Saints Catholic College to deliver additional support, such as individual tuition or intensive support in small groups, for those pupils that most need it.

Overview Year 7 Catch-Up Premium 2016-17

We have currently identified 41 pupils eligible for the catch-up premium in the academic year 2016-17. This is made up from:

Literacy ONLY	8 pupils
Numeracy ONLY	17 pupils
BOTH Literacy and Numeracy	16 pupils

The projected amount of funding for 2016-17 will be £9000. We plan to spend this in a variety of ways, including:

- Small group and one to one tuition- provided by external agencies
- Higher level teaching assistants to support with one to one literacy and numeracy
- Resources to support learning
- In-class support for literacy and numeracy will take place, and extra TA time allocation to support students in English and Mathematics lessons
- Reading Intervention (Accelerated reader and Tow by toe)
