Update for Home Learning Support

Dear Parent/Guardian,

First of all, we would like to say a huge thank you for all the support you have been giving to pupils at home. This has been a difficult time for everyone so well done for all the work we have seen taking place and being shared with us via Twitter and social media. If you haven't already, make sure you follow our whole school Twitter account [@allsaintscdduk](https://twitter.com/allsaintscdduk) as well as the various subject accounts we have on offer.

We wanted to take this opportunity to update you on how to continue to support your child with their home learning. All work, as you know, is currently being set using **Satchel:One** (Formally known as Show my Homework). We have had great success with this online learning tool so far but wanted to bring your attention to some additional home learning provided by our colleagues at the Oak National Academy. This is a virtual school that has been launched and provides live, teacher led, lessons throughout the week following the National Curriculum. It is a fantastic tool for parents worried about motivating pupils working from home. Missed lessons are also available to view and include some key assessment to track pupils' progress.

We highly advise parents in Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 to utilise this tool at home.


