Results Day for Year 11 examinations is Thursday 22nd August. All pupils can collect their results from 9.00am until 11.30 am. They will be distributed in the school canteen with pupils entering via the normal pupil gate onto the main yard.

If pupils are on holiday or are unable to collect their results on the day, alternative arrangements may be requested as long as pupils inform the College, in writing, of the alternative request. Results will not be distributed without written permission from the pupil.

If pupils are unable to collect their results in person they need to ensure that the enclosed Candidate Permission Form is completed and returned to school by 22nd August for the attention of Mrs Ahmet or it can be emailed to ahahmet@allsaintscatholiccollege.com

Postal results will be sent on 22nd August.

If pupils cannot collect in person then a named person can collect the results on the pupil's behalf, the named representative will need some means of identifying themselves alternatively they can have them emailed.

Support will be available for pupils requiring additional advice and guidance on receipt of their results.

Our GCSE results are published in the local paper and the Manchester Evening News. On the day your child will be asked to give permission to allow us to report to local newspapers the results of the school. This will include their name and GCSE results. As part of GDPR we must have their permission to do this. If you know in advance that your child would not like this and you would like your child's name omitted please contact school (Mrs Ahmet at ahahmet@allsaintscatholiccollege.com) asap and let us know.
