

Humanities

Year 11 – MS Teams teaching.

Lessons will be delivered live and pupils will upload the work completed that day.

Year 9 and 10 – First lesson will be a full MS Teams live lesson along, then half of the next lesson will be delivered live. Work uploaded at the end of that lesson or day.

The third lesson will be a recorded masterclass/class work on SMH with pupils expected to upload their completed work the same day.

KS3 – One lesson will be a MS Teams live lesson (following the plan) and the other will be a pre-recorded one that may have an element of live MS Teams teaching dependent on the lesson/pupils present.

Initially we may ask the pupils to save most work at home to be brought in and glued into books when they return but upload key pieces (one per fortnight) on SMHW for teachers to mark.

There will be some quizzing in the lessons where it is already planned but we had it in mind to do some when the pupils return to check understanding/completion. If the pupils do not attend the Live lessons then I was going to see what the whole school plan was later in our meeting - but I was presuming there would be a text sent home but as some pupils could miss 5 lessons a day it might be a centralised one.
