SCHOOL UNIFORM – SEPTEMBER 2026

I am writing to provide a gentle reminder regarding the planned changes to the school uniform, which will take effect from September 2026.

We are grateful for the valuable feedback received from both parents and pupils during the consultation process. Having carefully considered these views, the school has made the decision to support families with this transition by providing a new blazer free of charge for all pupils currently in Years 7 to 10.

To facilitate this, each pupil will be issued with an individual voucher, which will be exclusive to them and can be used to obtain their new blazer. This voucher can be redeemed at Top Marks Schoolwear in Ashton or at the pop-up shop being held in school.

In addition, there will be a change to the school tie. New ties will be available to purchase from school in advance of September at a discounted price of £4.50. Please note that this is an introductory price, and any additional ties purchased during the academic year will revert to the standard price.

To further support families, the school uniform supplier will be holding a pop-up shop in school on Sunday 19th July between 11:00am and 2:00pm, providing an opportunity to purchase items conveniently ahead of the new academic year.

With regard to knitwear, pupils may choose to purchase the new school jumper or continue to wear their existing jumper until they wish to replace it.

This decision has been made to strike a balance between supporting families financially during the transition and maintaining high standards of presentation and school identity. We believe this approach allows us to introduce a consistent and smart uniform while recognising the pressures that changes of this nature can place on families.
