Information in Response to DfE Guidance Relating to the Further Opening of Schools

General Guidance

We have set up bubbles for children so that they are, to a greater extent, isolated from children in other year groups. Year 7 will be their own bubble, Year 8 another, Year 10 a separate bubble, and Years 9 and 11 a bubble. In terms of the latter, they are a larger bubble as their school day matches but we have reviewed this and have put in actions which minimise their interaction. All classrooms will have hand sanitizing stations to allow students to clean their hands. We also have a one-way system in place for the main block. All classes are being set up to ensure that all children face the same direction and that staff are 2 metres away from the children.

Expectations

Our usual expectations apply:

- Full uniform
- No jewellery or makeup (including false nails)
- Hair natural colour and tied back
- Full equipment
- Rucksack/backpack not shoulder bag

Break and Lunch Time

At break and lunch time we have divided the school into separate areas so that the pupils remain in their bubbles. That includes access to the toilets which we will divide, where possible, between groups. The Mellor's Team will not be serving any items before school, or at breaks. Your child will need to bring a snack. We will offer sandwiches at lunch time which the pupils will have to order during the first 15 minutes of the school day.

Transport to School

In terms of transport to and from school we must continue to advise you to avoid using the public transport system, or where necessary to follow the safety protocols set up (masks, social distancing etc). The guidance remains, where possible, to walk or cycle to school. The school buses will run as normal. Please see note below about parking on Kenyon Avenue.

Parents will NOT be allowed to access the school site via Kenyon Avenue and we ask that you do not cause any additional congestion on this residential street by parking on it. The children will need to be dropped off elsewhere with time to walk to the appropriate entrance.

Hygiene

All students must wash their hands before arrival to school. Each classroom will be fitted with a hand sanitising station so that on arrival to class the students can clean their hands.

PPE

The current guidance is that pupils do not need to wear PPE whilst in school. Masks etc should be removed before pupils access the school site. Disposable masks must be binned - and children need to clean their hands.

Trips and Visits

Current advice is that we cannot offer any trips and visits.

Mass Gatherings

Current advice is that we cannot allow mass gatherings. This means that morning Collective Worship will be done within the first lesson (extended to 1 hour 15 minutes). Liturgical events such as Mass will need to be cancelled. Open Evening will also need to be cancelled.

Access to school

The current advice is that parents and visitors should not access school. Therefore, please do not come into reception unless you have a specific appointment. Information relating to planned Parents' Evenings will be distributed nearer the time.

Testing/ Trace and Track

If your child has tested positive for Covid-19 they are not allowed to access school for 7 days. If any member of their household, or anyone they have been in close contact with, has symptoms please **DO NOT** send your child into school. They must self-isolate for 14 days.

If a child develops symptoms during the day, they will be sent home and advised to self-isolate for 7 days. The government advice is that the child should have a test for Covid-19, details of which are on our website. As parents you **MUST** let us know the outcome of this test. You must also engage with the NHS trace and track service.

First Day Back Arrangements – Thursday 3rd September (Years 7, 10 and 11 only)

Following the guidance above about how your child should access the school, we do of course need to ensure that pupils have access to the right information and do know where they are going on the first day. The following table will explain where each form needs to be for the first session with us.
