NCFE Level 1/2 Technical Award in Graphic Design

Introduction and course overview

This course is aimed at students who would like an introduction to graphic design that includes a vocational and project-based element. The course will build your knowledge, skills and understanding around the following 6 content areas.

- à Components of graphic design
- à The work of graphic designers
- à Requirements of a graphic design brief
- à Planning, development and experimentation
- à Graphic design production
- à Displaying, presenting and promoting graphic design work

This course may be suited to you if you enjoyed Technology in years 7, 8 and 9. It will also allow you to progress onto a variety of creative courses including A-Levels and NCFE Level 3 courses.

Aims of the course

This qualification focuses on an applied study of graphic design and learners will gain a broad knowledge and understanding of working in the sector. The main aims of this course are;

- à To focus on the study of the graphic design sector
- à To develop a broad and comprehensive understanding of Graphic Design
- à Provide opportunities to acquire a number of practical and technical skills
- à To use materials, tools and equipment competently and safely
- à To enable progression to a range of study and employment opportunities
- à To develop a range of transferrable functional skills: reading, literacy, writing, numeracy, analysing, Interpreting, ICT, developing and communicating information

Method of assessment

NCFE Level 1/2 Technical Award in Graphic Design consists of the following two types of assessment;

à Non-Exam Assessment (NEA)

The NEA is an internally assessed project and is worth 60% of the overall grade, a total of 120 marks.

à Examined Assessment (EA)

The EA is a written examination (1 Hour 30 Minutes) which is worth 40% of the overall grade, a total of 80 marks.

Students studying the course will be awarded if they are successful a L1 Pass, L1 Merit L1 Distinction, L2 Pass, L2 Merit, L2 Distinction or L2 Distinction*
