

Welcome Message

As we reach the end of another school year, I want to take a moment to reflect on some of the amazing things pupils have achieved and experienced.

As a school, we have celebrated our Catholic faith through various endeavours, including: The Big Lent Walk, the Pilgrimage for the Year of the Jubilee, our carol service and through our collection of the icon and celebration of Mass with other local schools.

Pupils have taken part in some fantastic charity work this year. They raised over £3,300 for Willow Wood Hospice through their own entrepreneurial fundraising efforts and donated 160.4kg of food to our local food bank, as well as donating over £750 to CAFOD through their own achievement points.

Pupils have also taken part in several fantastic trips and experiences, including: the ski trip, French trip, visits to several colleges and universities including Oxford, a trip to Jodrell Bank, theatre trips, and attendance reward trips to the cinema and bowling.



Uniform & Appearance Policy

Pupils should return in full school 'winter' uniform and will need to have all items of uniform with them at all times, worn correctly. Girls wearing skirts must do so with black tights and not socks. Please ensure that pupils have school shoes.

Jewellery, make up and nail varnish are also not allowed, this includes any facial piercings. These must be removed for the duration of the school day. False eye lashes and false nails are also not permitted.

Please assist us in ensuring your child returns to school following our uniform and appearance policy. Should you have any concerns regarding any items of school uniform or regarding the appearance standards, then please do not hesitate to get in touch with your child's Progress Leader. Mobile Phone Policy

During the new academic year, we will be enforcing our new mobile phone policy in school. From 3rd September 2025, in order to safeguard all pupils in school, mobile phones will be classed as a banned item between the start and end of the school day.

If pupils choose to bring a mobile phone in to school, they must switch it off and lock it away at the beginning of period 1 in the specially designed mobile phone locker located in each form room. Pupils arriving after registration will hand their phone in at reception to be locked away. Alternatively, pupils may choose to leave their mobile phone at home.

Pupils will be dismissed back to forms 10 minutes prior to the end of the school day to collect their phones. Pupils leaving school before the end of the school day will be handed their phone back prior to leaving, e.g. needing to leave for a medical appointment etc. If pupils are in detention, they will receive their phone back at the end of the detention.

Year 10 and 11 Rewards Trip

We are pleased to inform you that a rewards trip to Blackpool Pleasure Beach has been arranged for Thursday 18th September for Key Stage 4 pupils. The information was shared with pupils at the start of the term. This exciting opportunity will be available to a limited number of pupils and will be by invitation only.

The cost of the trip will be approximately £40, which includes both transport and entry to the park.

Pupils invited to attend will be based on consistently good behaviour, effort, and attendance throughout this academic year that has just gone. Further details, including how to secure a place, will be shared during the first week back in school.



Arbor

From September, the school will be moving to a new system called Arbor for all electronic communication with parents and carers. Thank you to all parents and carers who have already registered their accounts. As a result, we will no longer be using “Class Charts” for parents or pupils. Through Arbor, you will be able to access important information such as your child’s attendance, behaviour records and timetable. For Pupils information on homework and assignments will be set via Arbor. An email link has been sent to parents and carers for you to be able to sign up. 






Sports Day
