Arbor

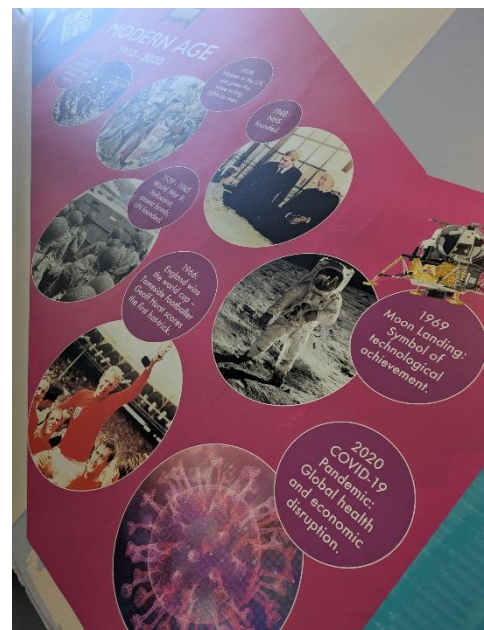
